It is perfect for salads that contain fruits, nuts and cheese, but it is great as a go-to for any green salad. The other has a mellow flavor of roasted garlic that comes together with Parmesan cheese. It also contains tomato, which gives it a slightly sweet taste. It is wonderful for pasta salads, roasted vegetables or just about any salad for that matter!
